

2024 REPORT TO THE TOWN OF BOULDER JUNCTION

GRANTS

Since its founding in 2010, the Boulder Junction Community Foundation has been dedicated to supporting local initiatives, contributing a total of \$1,670,819 in grants to enrich the community. In 2024, the Foundation proudly awarded the following grants totaling \$305,194:

- Boulder Junction Volunteer Fire Department - \$5,500
- Boulder Junction Chamber of Commerce - \$1,820
- North Lakeland Discovery Center - \$1,970
- Town of Boulder Junction, Basketball Court - \$52,266 (\$5000 & \$47,266)
- Town of Boulder Junction, North Creek Loop Trail - \$238,638
- Town of Boulder Junction, Zamboni for The Glide and Ice-Skating Rink at Winter Park - \$5,000

COMMUNITY FUNDS

We currently provide a range of Community Funds tailored to the unique interests of our donors: Bike Trail Enhancement Fund, Designated Fund, Donor Advised Fund, Field of Interest Fund, Greatest Needs Fund, Parks & Recreation Maintenance Fund, and Scholarship Fund.

ENDOWMENT FUND

As of December 31, 2024, the Endowment Fund reached \$953,379. The Fund is held and managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin. Grants are available annually through this fund. **OUR GOAL:** To raise \$1,000,000 in this fund which will enable the Foundation to give \$50,000 back to the community each year – FOREVER.

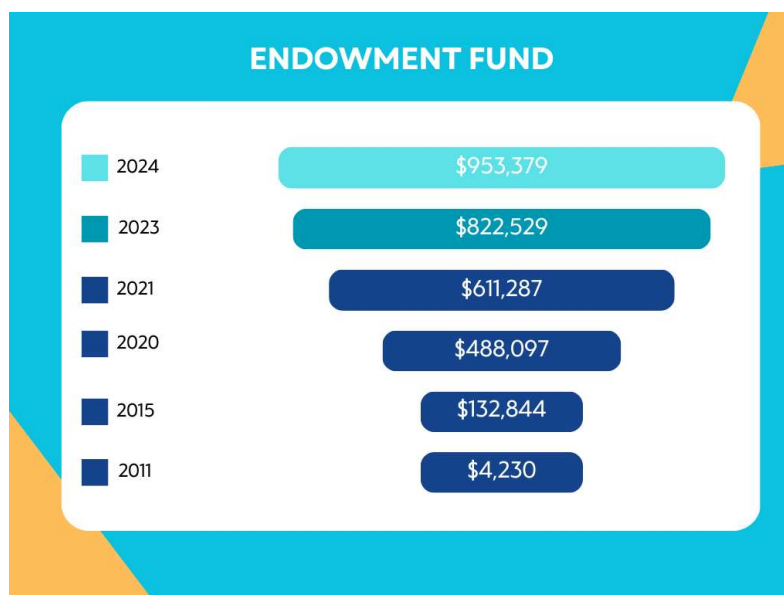
