BOULDER JUNCTION CHRISTMAS SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

To support the Boulder Junction, WI community by awarding scholarships to post-high school graduates who are residents of Boulder Junction and pursuing further education or training.

APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLICATION DEADLINE November 15

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Must be a resident of the Township of Boulder Junction
- Applicants must be post-high school graduates, including recent graduates, GED completers, and adult learners enrolled in degree, certificate, or vocational programs.
- Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis and may be awarded no more than five total years of support.
- Applicants are encouraged to be registered voters; however, eligibility is not restricted by voting status or age.

ANNOUNCEMENT

The recipients will be notified by email, phone, or physical letter before December 25 each year.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will receive a congratulatory email letter from the Community Foundation instructing them on how to receive their scholarship funding. The student must provide proof of registration to the Community Foundation office for payment to be initiated. The Foundation will make payment directly to the college or university the student is attending.
