Endowment Fund Milestone

In 2025, we achieved a historic milestone by reaching our \$1 million endowment goal set at our inception in 2010; the Endowment Fund balance closed the year at \$1,077,818. Our Family of Funds, including our Operating Fund, are held at Associated Bank. At the close of the year, the Operating Fund had a balance of \$12,705. In total, grants and distributions amounted to \$89,098. Our financial records continue to be professionally audited by Wipfli, LLP.
