

# 2023 REPORT TO THE TOWN OF BOULDER JUNCTION

#### **GRANTS**

Since its inception in 2010, the Foundation has awarded \$1,365,625 in grants to Boulder Junction and surrounding areas.

The following grants totaling \$443,176 were awarded in 2023:

### **COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT FUNDS**

We offer a variety of Community Enhancement Funds for the specific interests of our donors which include: Greatest Needs Fund, Bike Trail Enhancement Fund and Donor Advised Funds. Fiscal agreements with the town in 2023 were: North Creek Loop Trail Fund, and the Playground Fund.

#### RESTRICTED ENDOWMENT FUND

As of December 31, 2023, the Restricted Endowment Fund reached \$822,529. The Fund is held and managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin. Grants are available annually through this fund. **OUR GOAL:** To raise \$1,000,000 in this fund which will enable the Foundation to give \$50,000 back to the community each year... forever.
