GRANTS

Since its inception in 2010, the Foundation has awarded \$1,365,625 in grants to Boulder Junction and surrounding areas.

The following grants totaling \$443,176 were awarded in 2023:

- North Creek Loop Trail \$266,195

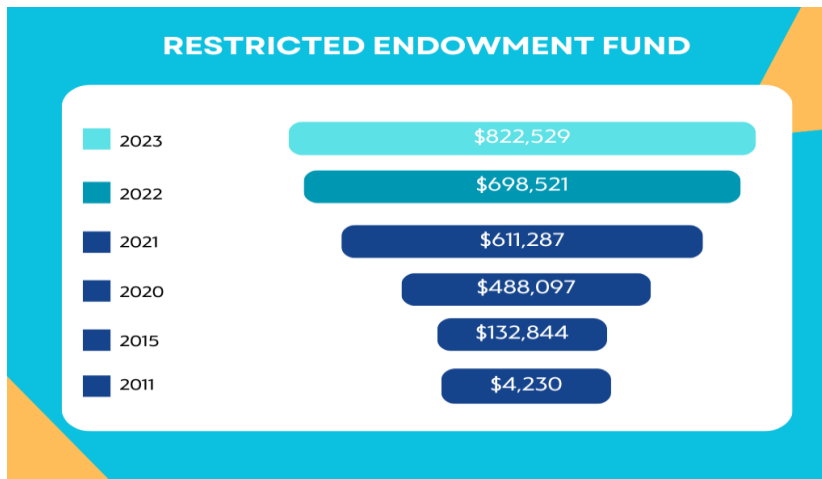
COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT FUNDS

RESTRICTED ENDOWMENT FUND

As of December 31, 2023, the Restricted Endowment Fund reached \$822,529. The Fund is held and managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin. Grants are available annually through this fund.
